Courses Eligible for Dual Enrollment (for 2021-22 school year):

Humanities (including English 101/102 and History 101/102), and Pre-Calculus with Trigonometry MA113, gives all students the opportunity to have 5 college courses completed at the end of their high school tenure. The PCS curriculum in Rhetoric school features accelerated courses in Geometry, Algebra II, Pre-Calculus with Trigonometry, Calculus, and Physics. Students complete Latin coursework in Grammar and Logic school.




- Fills in the gap that tuition does not cover toward the general operating fund of PCS in the areas of professional development, financial aid, facilities, diversity, and co-curricular priorities



As we train our students' affections, we seek to promote a peaceful, home-like environment in which the learner feels invited to participate in learning and is encouraged to seek the beauty of our Creator first.

The foyer of our grammar building speaks to what we value, love, and celebrate by featuring the five Solas, Sola Gratia (through grace alone), Sola Fide (in faith alone), Solus Christus (through Christ alone), Sola Scriptura (through Scripture alone), and Soli Deo Gloria (for the glory of God alone.) We are ordering a child's affections to something higher than themselves.

Grammar Teaching Methods:

- Learning through multi-sensory work to connect students as learners created by a multi-dimensional God
- Memorizing through songs, chants, and sound-offs, writing and performing skits, reading autobiographies, and dressing in costumes representing a literary character or historical figure

- Science: The development and testing of hypotheses, formal logic, debates, and persuasive reports
- Math: Evaluate and critique (with guidelines), logically orient numbers through the more abstract concepts of algebra and trigonometry




